UNDER PRESSURE ... by David W. Spillman

The late musician David Bowie had a hit song many years ago titled, *Under Pressure*. For many of us, those words "under pressure" are more than just the title of a song, but seems to be the anthem describing our lives. Work issues, demands of family, job searches, money shortages, automobile repairs, health concerns, and just trying to figure out what is going on in our country...all of these and many others have us feeling under pressure.

What normally is our recourse of action when our lives are running over with situations, circumstances and people who are continually exerting pressure? Do we find ourselves running away from any of these pressure cookers? Do we go into a denial phase where we ignore what is going on around us as, if somehow that will make things better? Do we selfmedicate using over-the-counter drugs that dull our senses or do we turn to alcohol to escape?

Look at these Words from James that the Holy Spirit breathed into him; "For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. So, let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be perfect and complete, needing nothing" (James 1:3 -4 NLT). What does God tell us to do when our faith is tested, when we are feeling pressure from so many angles? God tells us to endure! Instead of trying to wiggle our way away from pressure, He tells us to stay put and allow our faith to grow! This is how we become people of God who have a strong faith, a faith that completes us to where we need nothing but God, regardless of what comes our way!

Action point: Next time you find yourself in the pressure cooker, instead of calling on others to pray that God will rescue you from it, have others pray for your endurance, so you can see where it is God is wanting to grow you.
