## DIVIDED HEARTS . . . by David W. Spillman

As Jesus entered the city of Jerusalem for the last time before His death by crucifixion, Matthew records that a large crowd was shouting, "Praise God for the Son of David! Blessing on the One who comes in the name of the Lord! Praise God in highest heaven!" (Matthew 21:9 NLT). But then just a few days later after this event, Jesus finds Himself on trial before the Roman governor Pilate. With an exchange of words with this crowd in Jerusalem, Pilate asked, "Then what should I do with Jesus who is called the Messiah?' They shouted back, 'Crucify Him!' 'Why?' Pilate demanded. 'What crime has He committed?' But the mob roared even louder, 'Crucify Him!'' (Matthew 27:22-23 NLT).

It is easy for us to read this, shake our heads and think how fickle this Jerusalem crowd was concerning Jesus. One moment they are extolling His greatness and praising God because of Him, then in the next breath they are calling for His death by one of the most gruesome forms of execution imaginable, crucifixion! Talk about divided hearts, their hearts were as night and day concerning Jesus.

How about us? Is my heart all about praising Jesus when the circumstances are good, while at other times my heart and my allegiance are on the opposite end of the pendulum concerning Jesus? He said, "Anyone who isn't with me opposes me, and anyone who isn't working with me is actually working against me" (Matthew 12:30 NLT). Are you, am I, standing shoulder to shoulder with Jesus working with Him in this world? Are we with Him?


